RACT POLICY STATEMENT NO 13 RACT CORPS REPRESENTATIVES IN MILITARY REGIONS

INTRODUCTION

1. An RACT Corps Representative is to be appointed in each Military Region by the HOC. The appointee is to represent both the ARA and ARes RACT elements in the region.

AIM

2. The aim of this policy statement is to detail the responsibilities of the RACT Regional Representatives.

RESPONSIBILITIES

- 3. The RACT Corps Representative is responsible for:
 - a. providing a central point of contact for RACT activities in the region;
 - b. providing RACT advice to the Regional APAs as required; and
 - c. providing a focal point for the dissemination of RACT information both to and from the HOC within the regions complementing the chain of command.
- 4. Additionally each RACT Corps Representative is to establish/maintain close liaison with the RACT Colonel Commandant appointed to the region. They are to assist the Colonel Commandant to arrange visits to units, and is to ensure the Colonel Commandant is kept abreast of developments within RACT units in the region.
- 5. RACT Regional Representatives have direct access to the HOC and HOC Staff on matters arising from their responsibilities under this statement.
- 6. Annex A identifies the appointments selected as a Regional Representatives and their contact details.
