## RACT POLICY STATEMENT NO 15 RACT UNIT AND VEHICLE UNIT SIGNS

## INTRODUCTION

1. This statement has been prepared to ensure uniformity in the use of unit and vehicle signs by RACT units.

### **AIM**

2. The aim of this policy statement is to advise the design of, and the detail to be included in, RACT unit and vehicle signs.

## **POLICY**

### General

3. All RACT units are to display unit signs at their respective establishments and vehicle signs in accordance with Reference A. These signs are to be designed in accordance with this policy statement. Composite logistic units signs, flags, and vehicle signs are to be in accordance with Reference B.

## **Unit Signs**

- 4. Dimensions. As a guide, an overall width to height ratio of 1.5:1 should be used for the unit sign. A sign 175 cm wide and 114 cm high would be a suitable size. The specification is contained in AHQ Drawing ECD 16018A.
- 5. Format. The sign is to be a copy of the RACT flag with the RACT badge located in the centre. Colour specifications are contained in Annex A to this policy statement.
- 6. Unit\_Title. The unit title is to be printed, in block letters, in blue on the uppermost white band of the sign as shown in annex A to this policy statement.
- 7. In situations where more than one RACT unit occupy the same accommodation the title of the headquarters of the major unit is to be printed on the uppermost white band. The two title(s) of the other unit(s) is (are) to be printed on the lower white band of the sign. Parent formation titles may also be added to the sign on the uppermost white band.

## **Vehicle Unit Signs**

- 8. Vehicle Signs. Dimensions of vehicle signs are contained in Reference A, Chapter 6
- 9. Commercial Vehicles. In accordance with Reference C, unit and formation signs are not to be displayed on commercial vehicles.
- 10. Format. Vehicle unit signs are to be designed in accordance with Reference A, Chapter 6. Colour specifications are contained in Annex B to this policy statement.
- 11. Unit Serial Numbers. Unit serial numbers are allocated by Army Office (Directorate of Establishments) in accordance with Reference A, Chapter 12.


