RACT POLICY STATEMENT NO 13 RACT CORPS REPRESENTATIVES IN MILITARY REGIONS

INTRODUCTION

1. An RACT Corps Representative is to be appointed in each Military Region by the HOC. The appointee is to represent both the ARA and ARes RACT elements in the region.

AIM

2. The aim of this policy statement is to detail the responsibilities of the RACT Regional Representatives.

RESPONSIBILITIES

- 3. The RACT Corps Representative is responsible for:
 - a. providing a central point of contact for RACT activities in the region;
 - b. providing a focal point for the dissemination of RACT information both to and from the HOC within the regions complementing the chain of command;
 - c. providing advice and assistance to regional RACT Associations in conjunction with COL Comdt and actively promoting membership of serving members to the Association;
 - d. maintaining a regional Corps Contact list of Unit RACT Representatives to assist in the conduct of Corps activities and for the passage of information between HOC and COL Comdt;
 - e. assisting HOC Cell in the capturing and maintaining the Corps history from 2008 onwards; and
 - f. supporting regional RACT units and HOC Cell to coordinate submission of respective Army Unit History Reports (AUHR) by due date.
- 4. Additionally each RACT Corps Representative is to establish/maintain close liaison with the RACT Colonel Commandant appointed to the region. They are to assist the COL Comdt to arrange visits to units, and are to ensure the COL Comdt is kept abreast of developments within RACT units in the region.
- 5. RACT Regional Representatives have direct access to the HOC and HOC Staff on matters arising from their responsibilities under this statement.
- 6. Annex A identifies the positions selected for the Regional and Additional Representatives. These will be updated as required.
